

The earth belongs to God.


'the earth is the Lord's and the fullness of it; the world and those who dwell in it' Psalm 24.1




He was pleased with what He had made.

The ENTRANCE of SIN


'Through one man sin entered into the world

and so death passed to all men, for all have sinned."


